On behalf of our clients, culinary students, staff and Board of Directors, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your gift of **\$102.00 to support the Clara White Mission programs.** Your gift have restored lives through our job training program in culinary arts, employment placement, housing, youth services, daily meals and more. These essential services are the first steps to a new beginning. **In addition to serving over 179,000 hot meals to the homeless in our community annually 7 days a week.**

Since 2003, our program has housed 163 individuals and trained 191 individuals for a career in the hospitality industry in our certified culinary program. **76% of program graduates have acquired full or part-time employment within 30 days of graduation** from our job training program, and **50% of those placed in jobs currently remain employed.** Over the past year and a half, CWM program graduates are, **earning between eight and ten dollars an hour in the hospitality industry.**

The Mission's Greater Expectations youth program engages at-risk youth in a golf and tennis curriculum which also provides hot meals, academic assistance and family support. **The program serves approximately 100 youth annually. There are more than 700 "Greater Expectations" graduates in our community.**
